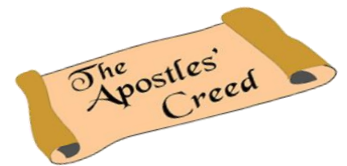

*In This Very Room*

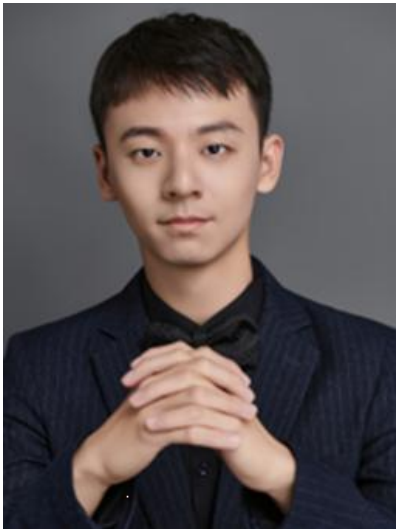
In this very room,
